## Harry Potter and the Classroom of Secrets

### English

This term, children will be using their core book, Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone, to help create engaging and challenging writing; including a finding story with a magical outcome and biography based on Leon and the Place Between.

### Maths

In maths, children will be focusing on fractions which include identifying the numerator and denominator, finding fractions of a number, adding and subtracting fractions. They will also be learning about decimals including dividing 1 and 2 digit numbers by 10.

### Science

Science this term will focus on states of matter and the links between the changing states things can transform into from a solid to a liquid to a gas and back again.

### History

Pupils will look at the history of magic and placing famous magicians on a timeline.

### Art/DT

Children will develop their knowledge of shell structures and their skills of building them. They will use computer aided design to design a book with a secret compartment.

### Music

Children will be revisiting their skills playing the ukulele and learning the song 'a spoon full of sugar.'

### Computing

This term, children will design, write and debug programmes that accomplish specific goals, including controlling or simulating physical systems and solving problems by decomposing them into smaller parts.

### R.E.

This half term, the children will be learning about different religions and their belief systems along with how these different belief systems have affected even non-religious people's lives. Children will be learning about different religious teachings e.g. the ten commandments.

Children will be practicing their hand eye coordination and working together as a team in tennis this term.
