Rule of Law

English

This term, pupils will be revising the full EGPS curriculum for Year 5 and 6. They will then apply this knowledge to writing a mystery in the form of an alternative ending to the book Holes. After this, they will be writing a persuasive leaflet advertising Camp Green Lake as a destination to visit.

Maths

Pupils will be refining their times tables skills and ensuring they are confident using an effective written method for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Measure will also be revisited

Science

In Science we will be consolidating our learning from previous terms.

Geography

In Geography, the children will be learning about volcanoes: the structure and inside of them; the effects of eruption on the environment; why people live near them; and what the Earth is made of.

Art/DT

In Art/DT, we will be linking it to our Writing topic. The children will be learning how to chop and use this to make onion dip.

Music

This term, children will continue learning to play the ukuleles, developing skills including tuning, counting in time, playing chords and reading music with confidence.

Computing

Following the Knowsley Scheme pupils will be learning about using ipads and safety on the internet in the 'My Online life' programme of study.

R.E.

This term the focus is Christianity. Pupils will look into rules and religious practices of Christianity.

P.E.

Tennis is the focus this term. Hand-eye coordination, balancing, hitting, aiming a ball will be practiced. Towards the end of the term, they will also be dancing. .

Personal Development

This term the focus is on independence. Pupils will focus on resilience, money debt and well-being, and tolerance
