Mission Impossible

English

In English, children will be using the EGPS skills they have honed all year (including passive voice, modal verbs, semi-colons, colons and parenthesis) to write in a range of genres: short stories, newspaper articles, a biography and instructions.

Maths

This term children will be continuing to refine their times table skills through working on fractions, decimals and percentages. In addition to this, children will work on solving worded problems.

Science

Science this term will explore the parts of the eye and how each part works, how light reflects in order for us to see the angle of incidence, how light refracts and how optical illusions are created. Children will also learn how materials with different opacity and transparency cause different shadows.

History

Children will be looking into how films have been made throughout history and how spies have been used as main characters in famous films since they started being made.

Art/DT

In art, children will be building on their drawing skills and working the style of an artist (Chuck Close). They will create an original piece of artwork which includes the use of a digital image, drawing, colouring and collaging, showcasing all of the art skills they have learnt.

The children will be using editing software to create, edit and publish a short film.
