We will be sharing learning through Showbie this term.

We will be dressing up as our favourite animals and making masks for them. We will also make a moving picture of our animal in their habitat.

Paws and Claws

English

This term we will use the "What Do You See?" books to innovate and write our own stories. We will use these books to focus on consolidating and extending our knowledge of adjectives and how they can be used to enhance our writing.

Maths

Our units for this term are place value within 50, length and height and mass and volume. Children will be developing their place value knowledge of tens and ones as well as exploring measurement.

Science

This term in Science our focus will be 'animals including humans'. We will learn about the difference between various species of animal and how to classify them.

Geography

We will be consolidating and extending on previous knowledge about the seasons, continents and oceans. We will be learning about the equator and the poles and comparing these places.

Art/DT

In Design and Technology we will be learning about wheels and axels. We will link this to our topic by creating a safari jeep that will move.

Music

In Music we will be using Charanga to explore the unit 'Learning to Listen'. We will be exploring how to listen and respond to music and how to listen to others.

Computing

Pupils will continue to develop their skills with the camera app, looking at the mark up tool and how to create memojji's in Notes. They will be creating their own memojjis of animals.

R.E.

For this term we will be continuing to explore "What makes some places sacred?". We will be making comparisons amongst different religions and our own beliefs, as well as exploring music from different religions and their meaning behind it.

P.E.

This term children will be introduced to the skill of 'striking and fielding', learning how to create barriers, bowl at a target and aim. They will also be developing their fundamental skills with catching and passing.
