Paws and Claws

Pride Time

This term we will be inviting parents in again to celebrate the learning from the term. We will create artwork based on our favourite animals.

Big Bang

We will be dressing up as our favourite animals and making masks for them. We will also make a moving picture of our animal in their habitat.

Learning Outside of the Classroom

We will make different types of mini-habitats that reflect habitats from around the world and match the animals to them.

Paws and Claws

English

This term we will use the "What Do You See?" books to innovate and write our own stories. We will use these books to focus on consolidating and extending our knowledge of adjectives and how they can be used to enhance our writing.

Maths

Our units for this term are multiplication and division, and fractions. We will use what we learnt in Reception about sharing and grouping equally.

Science

This term in science our focus will be 'animals including humans'. We will learn about the difference between various species of animal and how to classify them.

Geography

We will be consolidating and extending on previous knowledge about the seasons, continents and oceans. We will be learning about the equator and the poles and comparing these places.

Art/DT

In design and technology we will be learning about wheels and axels. We will link this to our topic by creating a safari jeep that will move.

Music

In music we will be using Charanga to explore the song 'Your Imagination'. We will use this to consolidate prior knowledge and create our own song.

Computing

Pupils will be continuing to learn the basic features of an iPad. We will be introduced to Pages and learn how to create documents on it using it's different tools. We will use our learning to create a poster about our favourite animals.

For this term our key question is "What does it mean to belong to a faith community?". We will discuss which communities we belong to in our daily life and link this to how religious people belong to communities.

P.E.

This term our focus is 'Net and Wall Game Skills'. We will practise how to aim for a target off the ground. We will do this by practising in small groups, encouraging taking turns in games and using teamwork to accomplish a goal.
