Dungeons and Dragons

English

This term pupils will be using a model text of The Tree Dragon to write their own conquering the monster tales. They will be creating their own dragons, orally rehearsing their stories and writing them. The children will also be creating some instructional writing pieces on how to catch a dragon to send back to Tim and his team of dragon hunters.

Maths

This term the children will be learning about shape, money, multiplication and division. They will be building on their skills of counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and will be applying this knowledge into real life contexts and problem solving.

Science

The children will be conducting an experiment over time, investigating the effects that different liquids may have on our teeth. They will be asking and answering scientific questions, making predictions and reporting results.

History

In History this term, the children will be learning about the history of castles, their development over time and some local castles.

Art/DT

In Art the children will be learning how to print. They will be developing an understanding of what printing is and the purpose of printing, with opportunities to practice different types of printing with a range of mediums. They will be finishing the term with a final project designing their own coat of arms, creating a repeated block pattern of this print.

Music

In Music, the children will continue following the glockenspiel course which will start their journey towards reading music notes on the treble clef staff.

Computing

We will be continuing to develop our coding skills this term, focussing on creating algorithms for a computer programme to follow.

P.E.

The focus in PE this term will be gymnastics - spinning, turning and twisting. We will be developing the fundamental movements skills within gymnastics.
