**English**

This term pupils will be using the core texts shown to write their own traditional tales of their own with a unique twist. There will be a focus on expanded noun phrases in EGPS to add description in their writing, learning how to apply adjectives and nouns correctly.

**Maths**

In Maths we will be developing our understanding of number and place value, looking at the amount of tens and ones in a 2 digit number.

**Science**

Science this term will have a focus on materials, building on previous learning in Year 1. We will be discussing where materials come from, how materials can be made into objects, their properties and their suitability. We will be conducting an experiment to see which materials would and would not be suitable for the Three Little Pigs to build a house from.

**History**

In History, we will be exploring life and works of Walt Disney. We will be looking at how film and animation has changed and developed over time, from the first animations to modern films.

**Art**

In Art, focussing on drawing skills. We will be learning how to use different pencil strokes and the effect different types of pencils create. We will be discussing the concept of tone and gradient, creating our own drawing of a Disney character at the end of the term.

**Music**

In Music, we will be exploring different percussion instruments and their uses. We will also be composing music for a traditional tale.

**Computing**

This term we will be focussing on the importance of E-Safety within our computing lessons. We will be discussing the importance of keeping safe online and knowing how to do this and who we can ask for help. We will be thinking about how to decide if information online is fact or fiction and why it is important to communicate politely online to trusted friends.

**R.E.**

In RE this term we will be studying the religion of Judaism. We will be exploring their beliefs, their precious items including the Mezuzah and some of their celebrations such as Shabbat and Chanukah.

**P.E.**

In PE we will be focussing on developing fundamental movement skills alongside playing some invasion games to build teamwork and communication.

**Personal Development**

This term the focus is on Respect, understanding and showing respect in different ways. We are also learning about kindness and how to be a good friend both inside and outside of the classroom.
