English

This term pupils will be using the text Iron Man to write a suspense story. Children will develop their understanding of how to build suspense by using the power of three, urgent dialogue and short punchy sentences. We will also be developing our non-fiction writing with non-chronological reports.

Maths

This term pupils will be continuing to develop our knowledge of multiplication and division as well as focusing problems involving money. They will also continue to develop their understanding of times tables.

Science

Science this term will focus on forces and magnets. We will explore the different types of forces including how objects move on different surfaces and how forces are measured.

History

In History, we will be exploring the history of the emergency services including the police, the NHS and firefighters.

Art/DT

In Art/DT, we will be looking at different colour palletes and using primary, secondary and tertiary colours to create their own piece of Pop art inspired by Andy Warhol.

Music
