Big Bang

Children will be immersed in Saxon and Viking History, with a visit from the Time Capsule Experience!

Pride Time

Children will be sharing mythical stories with their parents as well as showing parents how to create green screen movies and code using Osmo.

Learning Outside of the Classroom

English

Children will be writing a defeating the monster tale, writing an information text about different mythical monsters from Anglo-Saxon times.

Maths

This term, pupils will be continuing looking at decimals and thinking carefully about the value of each digit. Pupils will also cover adding, subtracting and estimating money. They will recap telling the time to the nearest minute, using a.m. and p.m., using a 24 hour clock.

Science

Children will begin to learn about frictional forces and magnetism. They will look at how magnets attract or repel each other dependant on the poles and will explore how different materials are either magnetic or non-magnetic. Friction will be explored by seeing how different materials move on different surfaces.

History

In History, we will be exploring the Vikings and Anglo-Saxons. We will be focusing on where they originated from, why they came to settle in Britain and their influence on how we live today.

Art/DT

Children will continue to focus on creating different textures and colours, making deliberate choices for their colour choices. They will design their own Viking sail which will be combined with all of the classes designs to create one big Viking sail to add to a Viking longboat for their final display.

Music

Children will be working with glockenspiels, building on their music theory including note names and symbols, their equivalent rests and time signatures.

Computing

Children will be using algorithms with Osmo coding. They will be building on their coding knowledge from last term to complete tasks on Osmo.

R.E.

Children will be learning about what we can learn from religions about deciding what is right and wrong and looking at a range of religions and their beliefs.

P.E.

Gymnastics and tennis is the focus for this term. Children will be working with a partner to practice pushing and pulling in gymnastics. In tennis, they will work collaboratively.

Personal Development

Children will be looking at pride, aspiration and achievement in their PD sessions. We will also cover ways to keep ourselves fit and healthy, both mentally and physically.
