All the World's A Stage

English

This term pupils will be using the text *The Twits*. Children will be using this text to write character descriptions, diary entries and writing a playscript. Children will also be working at improving their grammar and punctuation.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on Number: Place Value. Children will be learning about number up to 10,000 using manipulatives to represent their work in a variety of ways.

Science

Science this term will focus on light. We will explore how light travels and different natural and man-made light sources. We will also be investigating how light reflects on different surfaces.

History

In History, we will be exploring the history of theatre. We will be looking at and comparing theatre from a variety of ages, spanning from 55BC to current day.

Art/DT

In Art/DT, we will be linking it to our History topic. Children will learn about electrical circuits, developing their understanding of how simple circuits including switches, bulbs and batteries work. They will analyse different battery-operated products before designing and making their own theatre light linked to their topic.

Music

In Music, we will be exploring the different types of music that has been used in the theatre.

Computing

In computing, the children will be focusing on e-safety. Learning how to keep safe online.

R.E.

This term the focus is Hinduism. Pupils will look into what it means to be a Hindu in Britain today?

P.E.

Football is the focus this term. Dribbling, passing and movement skills, short/long distance shooting, control, attacking/defending based activities and small sided games will be practiced.

Personal Development

In health and relationships this term we will be learning about building positive relationships with others and how to seek support if children feel lonely. In Character Education we will be focusing on Respect and Honesty
