Stand and Deliver

Big Bang

Children will look at artefacts that Highwayman would wear or use and learn about the history of highwaymen.

Stand and Deliver

English

This term pupils will be using the text 'The Highwayman' to explore a range of characters in fictional descriptive writing. Using the Talk4writing approach they will develop their use of authors purpose by focusing on vocabulary and sentence structures to make their writing more interesting and enjoyable to read. After studying it, they will use the old English style of the poem to write.

Maths

In Maths, children will move on to fractions, decimals and percentages. They will need to continue using their times tables knowledge for this, as well as for recapping multiplication and division, and fraction topics previously covered.

Science

In Science, the children will be developing their knowledge about properties and changes of materials to describe how different materials have different properties. Each week, the children will look at different properties like transparent, opaque, waterproof and thermal conductivity.

History

In History, the children will be focusing on the local area and how it has changed over time. They will be learning about how the local area was used during the Elizabethan era and the early 19th century.

Art/DT

In this unit, children will be building on their knowledge of pulleys and gears. They will develop their technical knowledge of building circuits and using construction kits. They will be building up to designing a guillotine linked to their book 'The Highway Man'.

Music

The children will be learning about the Ukelele this term in music. They will learn how to read music and eventually learn how to play a song with different chords. By the end of term, the children will be able to tune a ukelele and change the pitch.

Computing

This term, Year 6 will be using Micro:bit to understand how computers work and how software and hardware work together. By the end of term, the children will be able to detect and correct errors in an algorithm and program.

R.E.

This term the focus will be on learning about the teachings, generosity and charities that Christians, Muslims and Humanists learn and live their lives by.

P.E.

In P.E., the children will be learning dance techniques to learn the dance The Haka, which is a ceremonial dance in Maori culture. They will also be practicing their basketball skills and use them in a match.

Personal Development

This term, Year 6 will be learning about noticing differences between people, differences and similarities in people, rule of law and dealing with conflict.
