## Visionary Victorians

### English

### Maths

This term pupils will be continuing to develop our knowledge of multiplication and division as well as length and perimeter. They will also continue to develop their understanding of times tables.

### Science

Science this term will focus on electricity. We will be looking at appliances that rely on electricity and how it flows through circuits.

### History

In History, we will be exploring the royalty of the Victorian era. We will also look at important discoveries and how innovative the Victorians were.

### Art/DT

In Art/DT, we will be focusing on developing our drawing skills. The focus will be on life-like portraits.
