Big Bang	Learning Outside of the Classroom

English	This term pupils will be writing a historical tale using their knowedge of Ancient Egypt. They will also write a non chronological report to showcase their knowledge of Ancient Egypt.
Maths	Children will continue learning about formal and mental methods of adition and subtraction, area and multiplication and division which includes formal written methods.
Science	Science this term will consolidate prior learning.
History/Geography	In History, we will be exploring the Ancient Egypt. We will be focusing on the location of Egypt globally and also looking at key geographical features within Egypt as well as features of everyday life for a person living in that era.
Art/DT	This term, the children will further develop their drawing skills by accurately identifying and rendering 2D and 3D shapes when drawing from observation or second-hand sources.
Music	This term the children will be learning how to use the glockenspiel to create Egyptian music.
Computing	The children will be designing their own apps based on encryption.
R.E.	This term the focus is Hinduism. Pupils will look into what it means to be a Hindu in Britain today. Including Diwali
P.E.	This term the children will be focusing on netball and hockey. The children will enchance their passing and shooting skills along with improving their ability to work as part of a team.
Personal Development	This term the focus is on collaboration and teamwork. The children will work on this during their personal development session, through deep discussion to understand other feelings and thoughts.
