Children will learn some key facts of WW2 and will present this knowledge in a variety of ways, using a UDL approach. Afterwards, they will create and build their own Anderson shelters, from a range of materials, with the aim of keeping a Lego person safe and dry.

Friend or Foe?

English

This term, children will be writing a World War Two suspense thriller based on *Once* by Morris Gleitzman. Their story will have an element of having to hide from a threat. Towards the end of the term, they will be writing a Newspaper report about The Blitz.

Maths

During this term, Year 6 will be moving onto fractions. They will learn how to find equivalent fractions and how to simplify them. They will be able to convert improper fractions to mixed numbers and vice versa. In addition to this, they will be able to add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions by integers.

Science

In Science this term, children will be learning about how light travels in straight lines. Children will also be looking at the different parts of the eye and how light is reflected into the it. They will explore refraction through different investigations.

History

In Autumn 2, students will continue to get an understanding of their local area, looking at how the local area has changed over time. A focus will be on World War Two, including evacuation, where was bombed, rationing and key events of the war.

Art/DT

In Art/DT students will be create Anderson shelters out of a range of materials, including cardboard and plastic. They will have to work with different adhesives and work carefully on skills such as cutting, sticking and designing.

Music

This term, children will continue to learn to play the recorders, developing their skills including counting in time, playing chords and reading music with confidence.

Computing

Children will be building their own website this term. They will learn what a website is and the main components needed to build a successful website. Their website will be exported as an HTML file and be uploaded.

R.E.

This term the focus will be on learning about the teachings, generosity and charities that Christians, Muslims and Humanists learn and live their lives by.

P.E.

In P.E., the children will be learning the fundamental skills of keeping fit and healthy through exercise. They will also be participating in outdoor and adventurous activities.

Personal Development

This term, Year 6 will be learning about noticing differences between people, differences and similarities in people, rule of law and dealing with conflict.
