Dear Families,

On **Tuesday 5th November 2024, Years 1,2,3,4,5 and 6** will be taking part in their launch days for their new topics. This is a fun day for the children full of activities that introduce their new topic and the learning that they will be doing. Please see the table below to see what the topic is about and if they can come into school dressed up. Topic overviews for the term will also be sent out so you can see in more detail what your child will be learning.

Year Group	Topic Title	Information
Year 1	Planet Protectors	Please dress in green. We will be designing eco-warrior capes and masks to create our own eco-warrior identity.
Year 2	There's No Place Like Home	Year 2 will be finding out about different London landmarks by going on a hunt around the school. We will be decorating Royal Guards, learning about the Royal Family and even having a spot of afternoon tea! Children can wear red, white or blue linked to the Union
Year 3	I Need A Hero!	We are dressing up in superhero outfits – including everyday superheroes like nurses, doctors etc or they can also just wear colourful clothing. They will have a chance to crack codes, create their own superhero and film their own superhero movie trailer!
Year 4	Tomb Raiders	Year 4 will be learning about Egyptian life. They will look at hieroglyphics and writing messages using the symbols associated. They can come in dressed up as anything Egyptian.
Year 5	Into the Unknown	Children will be growing their own salt crystals and creating their own origami snowflakes to accompany their arctic scenes. To recreate colours of the arctic, children can come in dressed in blue, white or silver. Please can children bring in any cardboard boxes they have at home.
Year 6	Friend or Foe	Children can dress up as part of the army, an evacuee, VE Day or part of the Women's Land Army. The day will all be about the war and what evacuation was. Pupils will be making Anderson Shelters. Children to bring in egg boxes, cereal boxes, shoe boxes and bubble wrap
